Call for applications:

Mobility Scholarships for Postgraduate Foreign Students

Grants are offered to cover:

- A term from 1 to 5 months for mobility or research stays in UAM's postgraduate programs (both Masters and PHD level).

Scholarship benefits:

- Waived registration and tuition.
- Stipend amount of \$ 8,000 Mexican pesos (equivalent to 600 USD approx.) per month.

Applicant's Profile:

Preference shall be given to applicants who:

- Choose a program about key issues for their country's development.
- Are not benefitted with another scholarship from the Mexican Government.
- Have a minimum GPA of 8 on a 0 to 10 scale, in the last academic year. If the scale is other than the stated, it is important to present its equivalence.
- Reintegrate in their country at the end of the mobility scholarship.

General Requirements:

1. Mobility application form.
2. Scholarship application form.
3. Official presentation letter from the home institution.
4. Transcript of records.
5. Letter of intent.
6. Copy of the passport.
7. If the applicant speaks other language than Spanish, he/she must add a proficiency in Spanish language certificate, issued by a University or Educational Institution.
8. Acceptance letter of the intended study program proving the duration and the start and end dates of the program, signed by the UAM's postgraduate program Coordinator in letterhead and with handwritten signature.
9. Copy of the international health insurance covering the stay period.

INCOMPLETE FILES WILL NOT BE RECEIVED. No files will be returned.

Validity term of the Call for Scholarships:

- a) This call for scholarships will be valid from September 3rd 2012 to February 28th 2013.

Application procedure:

Applications must be introduced by the Postgraduate Coordinator of the corresponding UAM program. The documents should be sent, both in .pdf and paper, directly to the Coordinación General de Vinculación y Desarrollo Institucional at Universidad Autónoma Metropolitana, through the following contact details:
