Nomination process

Step 1: Performed by the Home University

The International Office must nominate by e-mail their students interested in coming to Icesi, filling in the following data:

Full name	Field of Study at home university	Study level at home university	Number of study years prior the exchange	Program chosen at U. Icesi	Proposed period of study	E-mail

Step 2: To make by the student

The student must fill out the **Admission Form**, sent to following **documents DIGITAL**, by email, to any of Assistant for International Relations Office:

- Letter from the home university presenting the student
- Transcripts covering the last three years
- Passport photocopy (personal information page)
- 1 Printed photo (3x4 cms)
- Motivation essay of maximum two pages (in English or in Spanish)
- Resume/CV (in English or in Spanish)
- Two signed academic letters of reference
- Health good standing certificate

- It is mandatory to come to Universidad Icesi with a B1 Spanish level, certified by the Language Department at the home university or any other institution authorized to do so.
- Visa *
- International health insurance *

(*) After receiving our acceptance letter.

Those students interested in extending their exchange program, must present an authorization from their home university as well as a new visa, new international insurance and new foreign ID.

“Español como Lengua Extranjera” course

A Spanish exam will take place during the orientation week for those who wish to take the “Español como Lengua Extranjera” course. This exam will determine the student's level. Course materials are included.

This course is not mandatory (except for the Double Degree students) but we strongly recommend all exchange students to take it. The course will not give credits. The tentative schedule is Tuesdays and Thursdays from 17:00 to 19:00 hrs, and it starts one week after the beginning of the academic semester.

Orientation week for international students

During the orientation week, the International Relations Team will do several important activities for our international students. That is why it is mandatory for students to plan their arrival to Cali to assure their participation from the first day.

Activities:

- Academic enrollment.
- Spanish diagnostic exam and Spanish classes registration (for those who need it).
- Students must register their visa to *Migración Colombia* authorities to get their foreign ID. This procedure costs \$187.000 COP (Colombian pesos) approximately; credit card payment is suggested.
- City tour.
- Integration activities for the exchange students.
